

ICCCAD-IUB Youth Climate Discussion on COP21



As part of the ICCCAD Climate Youth Initiative (CYI) programme, a discussion session will be held focusing on delivering **knowledge and awareness** on current scenario of **climate change negotiation** among young people in Bangladesh. This is the 2nd time such event is being organised by ICCCAD-IUB. A similar event was held in late August at Independent University, Bangladesh (IUB) titled "**Pathway to Paris**" which included presentations from climate knowledge experts **Dr. Ainun Nishat** and **Dr. Mizan R. Khan** followed by a workshop on vulnerable sectors to climate change in Bangladesh. The Daily Star online edition featured a report on this workshop. Radio Shadhin worked as the media partner of the **event**.

The next workshop will be held at IUB which aims to train young people about international climate conferences such as COP (Conference of Parties) through discussion and presentations of other youth organisations. This will facilitate them to be engaged in climate change related actions and encourage them to represent not only their country but also the youth of the world in future COPs.

The expected number of *participants is around 50* consisting mainly of university students, youth and environmental activists with *10 observers* from NGOs.
