Learning objective: Strengthen government capacities to access, manage and deliver international and national climate finance more effectively

Course Structure: 3-day professional training, 1-day cross country learning, 1-day field visit. The course will cover 4 modules:

- 1. National governance of climate finance
- International landscape of climate finance
- Sub national mechanisms for devolved financing
- 4. Public private financing for climate change responses

Course fees:
