

CONTENT

The course will focus on

- Approaches to inclusive and sustainable urban development
- Urban vulnerabilities and their linkages with other human factors exacerbating climate stresses
- Methods of assessing local needs and vulnerabilities, and potential approaches to addressing those needs

The course contents will be delivered using classroom lectures, case studies and a field visit within Dhaka.

WHO IS IT FOR?

The course is aimed at municipal officials and practitioners from urban centres in Bangladesh, with a focus on cities engaged in the National Urban Poverty Reduction Program and cities facing climate-related challenges.

TIMELINE

- Five day short course to be held from the 4th to the 8th of June, 2017
- Last date to Apply: 15 May 2017

FEES

USD 1,000 or BDT 75,000 including tuition fees, accommodation and living costs. Limited stipend available for highly deserving candidates (conditions apply).

Full fee waivers can be allowed for up to ten deserving candidates who apply before 10th May 2017.
