Recommendations for the Transitional Committee under UNFCCC to work in 'reality time' rather than 'UNFCCC time'

DO NOT OPERATE ON 'UNFCCC TIME'

- Victims of climate change impacts need your help today, not tomorrow.
- Get something up and operational by COP28 rather than COP29 or COP30.
- Do not make the perfection the enemy of good enough! An imperfect fund that starts to operate quickly is better than waiting years for the first dollar to be delivered

PARTNER WITH EXPERIENCED ACTORS

- Make the fund fit for purpose by partnering with global humanitarian actors like UN OCHA, the Red Cross, the Red Crescent and the World Food Programme (WFP), etc. experienced in providing anticipatory funds.
- Gear focus also on impacts due to slow-onset weather events like sealevel rise that displace thousands

BECOME A FORMATIVE VOICE

- Become the main voice and explainer of what loss and damage entails with a robust and effective communication strategy for all your work on a rapid and regular basis.
- Welcome and facilitate the engagement of observers to each of your meetings and meet with us after each meeting to share outcomes and be open to engagement from us.
